## 2. Opening of the Meeting

The Fifth meeting of EACO Working Group 1 on ICTs Policy and Regulatory Frameworks Harmonization (WG01), was held in Kigali, Rwanda; from  $5^{\text{th}}$ - $7^{\text{th}}$  October 2015, with a welcome remark by the Chairperson, Ms. Fortunata Mdachi, - from Tanzania Communications Regulatory Authority (TCRA).

Members present were welcomed by the EACO Liaison Manager, Mr. Godliving Kessy noting apologies from Regulators of Burundi and Uganda. It was further noted that only one operator from Tanzania attended the meeting and it could not be established as to the reason for the absence of the other operators.

## 4. Appointment of Rapporteurs

Ms. Lyn Cherono (CA of Kenya) and the Liaison Manager/Counsellor, agreed to be rapporteurs of the meeting.

The Liaison Manager, Mr. Godliving Kessy informed the meeting of ongoing joint ICT Projects by ITU, Chinese Government and EAC and the EU initiative toward harmonisation of the ICT Policies within the EAC. It was noted that these Projects may have a bearing on the work of WG1.
