



**FINAL COMMUNIQUE OF THE EACO 1<sup>ST</sup> ADVISORY COUNCIL**

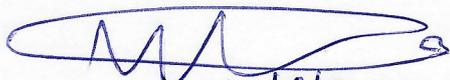
**HOSTED BY NCA – SOUTH SUDAN AT RADISSON BLU HOTEL**

**13<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2025**

- 1) East Africa Framework on Communication Mechanism among the National CERTs/CIRTs was launched;
- 2) Agreements on the East Africa Framework for Communication Mechanism among National CERTs/CIRTs were signed by Heads of National Regulatory Authorities of the EACO Partner States and CERTs Authorities;
- 3) East Africa Regional Statistics Report (telecommunication) for 2024 was unveiled;
- 4) The ICT regulators should establish collaboration with the relevant agencies such as Central Banks on issues of co-regulation of mobile financial services;
- 5) The Working Groups & Committees require a minimum representation of two participants from each Partner State to enable continuity of work;
- 6) The title of Working Group 3 was revised as following, “CONSUMER PROTECTION ISSUES, QUALITY OF SERVICE, AND CYBER SECURITY”;
- 7) Encourage participation of Operators (Postal, Telecom and Broadcasting) in the activities of EACO i.e Working group meetings, workshops, trainings, conferences, Assemblies and Advisory Council;
- 8) Operators urged to fully participate in the activities of cross border frequency coordination and ensure effective collaboration between operators and regulators as they resolve cross-border challenges. MNOs are also encouraged to deploy border roaming solutions to mitigate forced roaming;
- 9) NRAs and operators to continue facilitating their officials to attend all EACO meetings to enhance productivity in realizing the Strategic plan;

- 10) 31<sup>st</sup> Assemblies will be hosted by Republic of Rwanda in June 2026;
- 11) 32<sup>nd</sup> Assemblies and 2<sup>nd</sup> Advisory Council will be hosted by United Republic of Tanzania in June 2027;
- 12) The following 17 documents were adopted and endorsed from the work of the Working Groups and Committees:
